TOWARDS INCLUSIVE AND ENGAGING RURAL AND MOUNTAINOUS AREAS

Amidst the prominence of urbanization as a global trend, and migration as of its key driving forces, the impact and development potential that migration can bring to rural and mountain regions have become neglected. Migration can have a major impact on social and economic development, social innovation, revitalization of remote spaces, and the urban and rural nexus, yet for this happen adequate policies and applicable practices are needed that take into account spatial specificities and context dependencies. Evidence-based knowledge on migration outside urban areas is needed to include migration in the policies to promote balanced and sustainable development and to reduce territorial inequalities.

The three-year research project MATILDE, funded by EU Horizon 2020 facility, has investigated the social and economic impacts of migration in rural, peripheral and mountainous regions of Europe. The international conference will discuss the results from the ten participating countries (Austria, Bulgaria, Finland, Germany, Italy, Norway, Spain, Sweden, Turkey and the United Kingdom) and 13 case study regions, but also highlight ways to promote socially inclusive and territorially balanced growth by stimulating the potential for local development through migration and coexistence characterized by diversity. This conference aims to provide space to improve the dialogue between researchers, policy-makers and various social and economic milieus in order to provide better responses to the challenges posed by migration and integration governance.
